Sun Protection Policy

Introduction

The purpose of this policy is to clarify the position with regard to sun safety and seeks to encourage the health, safety, well-being and education of all pupils attending Sharneyford Primary School. This policy has been agreed by governors and all teachers representing Foundation Stage, Key Stage 1, Key Stage 2 and Sunrise and Sunset Clubs.

Objectives

This policy will ensure that:

- 1. All pupils are educated about sun safety through PSHE lessons.
- 2. Ensure that school staff take suitable precautions to ensure children are safe during outdoor activities.
- 3. All parents are made aware, annually of the school sun protection policy.

Strategies

To develop sun protection the following measures will be put in place:

Parents/carers will provide:

- 1. Hats between April and September.
- Apply long-lasting high factor sunscreen before school. There are many brands of one application sunscreens available which last the whole day.

School will:

- 1. Seek to provide shade wherever possible.
- 2. Talk to the children at the start of the Summer Term outlining the dangers of not protecting our skin in the sun.
- 3. School staff will not apply sunscreen to children
- 4. Ensure that during very hot weather children are not outside for prolonged periods.
- 5. Provide water bottles
- 6. Ensure water fountains are maintained termly and allow children access to water throughout the day.
- 7. Provide sun hats for sports day.
