To have singing assemblies and have the opportunity to join the school choir. To have the opportunity to take part in the Christmas play & music concerts. KS1 & Year 3 pupils to be taught via Music Express or Charranga. To ensure staff plan lessons alongside KLIPS and the National Curriculum. For each class to perform a Christmas play in front of parents. 	 For children to enjoy their musical experiences in school. Get pupil views to ensure good learning and progression. Children will achieve age related expectations in music at the end of their cohort year. Children will retain knowledge that is pertinent to music. Children will have the opportunity to foster their instrumental flare and use this as a form of expression.
