<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We want our children to be motivated to learn about and from, the past. • Our curriculum equips pupils with knowledge about the history of Britain and how it has influenced and been influenced by the wider world; • know and understand about significant aspects of the history of the wider world like ancient civilisations and empires; • changes in living memory and beyond living memory; • learn about the lives of significant people of the past; • understand the methods of historical enquiry and be able to ask and answer questions. • We want children to enjoy and love learning about history by gaining knowledge and skills, not just through experiences in the classroom, but also with the use of fieldwork and educational visits. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In KS1, History is taught each half term and is linked, where possible, to the class theme. • In KS2, History is taught three times per year and is alternated with Geography. • Consideration is given to ensure there is progression across the topics throughout the year for all year groups. • Cross curricular outcomes are planned for and the local area is fully utilised to achieve the desired outcomes, with extensive opportunities for learning outside the classroom. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The majority of children in each year group are working at or above the expected level for their age. • Children are assessed according to their Key Stage National Curriculum requirements based on their progression in skills and knowledge. • We want our children to enjoy and be inspired by the History curriculum and be able to show progression in their skills and knowledge. • We monitor the subject through lesson observations, book sampling and speaking to children.
